P1: Phone = Google Home = Tablet > Notebook

“Notebook would be used least, For sure. I would write on a scrap of paper and then later go back and use google or tablet and enter it”

All others have equivalent convenience due to context of use: “if I'm out and about, then If there's a spike I have no idea if I'm not home, or I'm outside.... it depends on what I'm doing at the time. If I'm busy cooking and it goes off, I can just yell at it... I can see using either of these three equally depending on the situation.”

“I would be more likely to remember to [annotate] with a text. After that, if I had to do it, notebook would be last, then google. I'm more likely to go through the tablet [...] and make a note. If I had to choose: text message first (to immediately reply), then tablet (to look back at the end of the day to know what's going on) then google... maybe if I'm in the moment and I think to mention it.”

“[I'm] More likely to annotate if I knew there was something happening”

P2: Phone > Google Home > Tablet > Notebook

the phone texting is one of those where if I can respond right away, and I'm not needing to think about "oh, I need to make a note of this...." would be fantastic for me. Cause I almost always have my phone on me and it's one those things with -- even with the reminder's to fill out [eAT]....if it weren't for the reminders I wouldn't remember to do it, even though it's been months already that we've been doing it. [laughs]

Google Home is one where where if I'm vacuuming or in the kitchen I would probably be like "Ok, I can mention it really quick"

Tablet again would be one of those.... [long pause, weighing options].... Probably with this I would look at it once a week and then go back and see "Oh yeah, I remember this is what it was"

Notebook? Honestly, I'm lazy and would just wouldn't do it. [laughter]

P3: Phone > Google Home > Tablet > Notebook

[Text] I think most times I can send a quick text. Most instances. Even if I have to wait, it's still "there". With eAT, the only reason I EVER do it is because I go through my text, go through my e-mails and go [quiet sheepish] "Oh yeah, I really need to go do that...". Otherwise I would NEVER remember, unless he [son] had an asthma attack. that's why I think it would be really good for me.

[Google Home] I think it's easy to just say "this is what I'm doing right now". I wouldn't even have to stop what I'm doing. I could be doing it as I'm getting whatever out of the fridge, or there's a fire outside , or whatever.

[Tablet] It's convenient... I think it's more convenient than the thing [notebook], but it's still the same issue as having to sit down and remember to do it. I think I would remember more than writing, but I don't think...I still think I would do it less often with the tablet than I would with something that was just really convenient and "right there"

[Notebook] I just won't do it. It's one of those things where if you have to write it down, I'm either doing something and it's like "yeah, OK, I'll remember to do that in a minute", and then... it just doesn't happen

P4 - Phone > Home > Tablet > Notebook

If I were a stay at home, then google would be the easiest -- I wouldn't have to stop what I'm doing. I could just say "this is what happened -- google, I burnt dinner!" and mark it, while I'm busy with the fire extinguisher. It would be very handy. but I'm not at home very much [exasperated], so the texts do work better.

I *do* like the tablet. The tablet wouldn't be such a big deal *if* I carried it around like I do my cellphone. But because this [tablet] is going to be in her [P4a's] room, and I'm hardly ever in her room, then it's just not convenient for me

Regarding ranking notebook last: I wouldn't be carrying it around with me. If I wrote anything down someone would have to move it over here[tablet]

P4a: Tablet > phone > Home > Notebook

I liked the tablet best because we're at home and "here". We don't have to contact anybody, we just type it in. It's also helpful to get a text because if you're not home, you can know that something spiked, and you'll be able to realize that before you get home, and you can look at the tablet. [P4] gets the text messages, and she likes those ones better so...

(P4a was also not receiving texts for the deployment. She is a student and depending on the timing of the spikes, it may not be appropriate for her to respond to texts during school hours)

Regarding ranking notebook last: I'm lazy It looks like those school notebooks, [so I'd be afraid I'd take it]. It's just that these ones [tablets] are more convenient. they're gonna be here and we're going to be here, going to them to look at them, then we can just write it down. On the phone or tablet or google home, and it's in here. And the notebook. Whatever drawer it's in, you pull it out and write it down and the date, and somewhere down the line, you'll have to pull it back out...
